League Rules

LEAGUE RULES

The following rules will be utilized for the league:

- Blood Bowl Rule Book: 2020 Edition (BB2020)
 - All FAQs, designer commentary, and errata
 - Teams of Legend was released by Games Workshop and the Historical Teams by the NAF. This file can also be found on the Hub City Blood Bowl Facebook page or at the following links:

 - Star Players – rules will be followed as on page 92 of the Rule Book.
 - Inducements include:
 - Standard inducements
 - (0-2) Star Players
 - (0+) Mercenaries from Core Book
 - (0-3) Mercenaries from Death Zone
 - (0-2) Infamous Coaching Staff
 - (0-1) Wizards
 - (0-1) Biased Referee
 - (0-1) Giant Mercenary
- Death Zone rule book
 - Inducements from pages 14-39 can be used
- The league will be run using the recommended league fixtures and scoring outlined on pages 97-98 of the BB2020 rulebook.
- The first phase of the season will be round-robin (meaning every coach plays a game once). If enough players are registered, divisions will be created. After the completion of this phase, the playoff phase will begin. If applicable, division leaders will face each other. Depending on the number of teams, wild-card teams will also be added to the playoff format.
 - Season 3 Standings and Playoffs - At the end of the season, the top 4 teams will advance to the playoffs - based on the top 4 scoring teams. Tie breakers are based on the most touchdowns, then the most casualties.

MVP

The league will use the Pick 3 rule for MVP SPP assignment: after the game, the player will choose 3 eligible players from their team. TourPlay will then randomize the MVP choice from those 3 players.

SCHEDULE

The following schedule will be utilized for the league:

The league will be run on a 1-game-every two-week schedule. You and your opponent will need to play your game during the allotted time before the drawing of the next fixture - failure to complete the game on time will be handled per the guidance of the "League Fixtures" section of the BB2020 rulebook, page 97.

Scheduling:

- Divisions will be created based on the number of players at the end of the registration. Rules for the playoffs will be adjusted once all teams have finalized registration
- Two games per week is the league maximum: One league/division game and one ***optional*** exhibition game. However, if your team is on a "bye" week, you can play ***TWO*** exhibition games. (No byes in Season 3 however)
- You can gain SPP (Star Player Points) from an exhibition game, and any casualties ***WILL*** carry over after the game.
- You can play against ***ANY*** HCBB Season 3 team (even in your own division) for an exhibition game.

TEAM BUILDS

Use the following when drafting your team for league play:

- The team draft budget will start at \$1,000,000 – see page 33 in the Blood Bowl Rule Book
- Although having a painted, numbered team is ideal, it is not mandatory. If you are unable to have your team painted when the league starts, please make sure that each player on your team is identifiable and distinguishable (numbers on the bases). Players need to have individual names as skill/stat increases are recorded on TourPlay.net
 - Tour Play keeps track of your team's players' stat increases and makes stat tracking VERY EASY. Also, a great way to keep the league organized, and you can look at other league teams' rosters.

REQUIREMENTS

- Players will need to pay \$10 to register for the league. These costs will go to paying for the Tourplay.net app which has a monthly fee. The more players, the higher the cost per month. Payment can be made in the following ways:
